## National experts converge on Springwood for first ever Bushfire Building Conference

Leading Australian experts will converge on Springwood for the inaugural Bushfire Building Conference on 18 September. The conference is the only national event that brings together builders, architects, designers, planners, researchers, regulators and insurers to explore issues around building in a bushfire-prone area.

Presented by Blue Mountains Economic Enterprise (BMEE), the conference will see SBS *Insight*'s Jenny Brockie bring her considerable talent to the Blue Mountains as MC for the day.
